<p>INTERVIEW WITH 1. N, Civilian, was interviewed at his home and provided information concerning an incident he witnessed in Vietnam in November 1967 when <del>SUBJ</del> allegedly shot and killed a USMC military policeman while attempting to escort a convoy of Viet cong soldiers into Camp Book, Red Beach, Danang. N was given a statement prepared by 1STLT Phillip S. BANKS III, USMC, and advised the statement contained the correct information regarding this incident which he had imparted to BANKS at an earlier date. N stated he had no further information to relate beyond what was contained in the statement and signed the statement in the presence of Reporting Agent. Reporting Agent administered an oath to N concerning the contents of the statement. Copy of N statement is Atch (1). (04-27-81)</p> <p>USE OF PHOTOGRAPHS FOR IDENTIFICATION 2. In accordance with the instructions set forth by 1STLT BANKS, a photo line up was conducted with N Reporting Agent and ROGERS both signed the mandatory procedure for presenting photographs as prepared by 1STLT BANKS and a copy of this document is Atch (2). N viewed all five photographs and stated photographs A, B, and E were definitely not of the person he remembered from his Vietnam experience. N stated photographs C and D both bore a resemblance to the man he had seen shoot the MP and ultimately picked photograph C as the picture which he felt most resembled the man he had seen. N stated however, that picture D also bore a resemblance and said he would like to see a picture of that man in which the man did not have a smirk on his face. N said he might better be able to make a judgement since he was somewhat distracted by the smile on the man's face and felt SUBJ should have nothing to smile about. N signed the form documenting his identification of the photograph and a copy of that form is Atch (3). (04-27-81)</p> <p>DISPOSITION OF ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS 3.
