Subject: Report of Interview with Alleged Missing American Serviceman

1. On 26 January 2009, JPAC requested Analyst assist [redacted] VFW in Virginia, who had called them to report information he received about John Hartley Robertson (Refno 1184). On 12 February, Analyst spoke with [redacted] who explained [redacted] claims to have seen and spoken with an unaccounted-for American – John Hartley Robertson. Analyst informed [redacted] that [redacted] sister-in-law had already provided DPMO with information and photos of [redacted] meeting with the alleged American.

2. Analyst informed [redacted] that this report correlates, by name, to SFC John H. Robertson (1184) who is currently unaccounted-for. However, the biographic data and photographs of the alleged American show this is a bogus report. The man identified as SFC Robertson was interviewed by U.S. personnel in 2006, at which time the man admitted he is actually Dang Than Ngoc (aka Dang Tan Ngoc), a Vietnamese citizen who has been involved in similar bogus reports for several years.
