PREAMBLE: SOURCE was interned in a Russian convict forest camp (No. not recalled) within the MORDOVIA District near POTMA (Approximately 54 03N/43 06E) from December 1948 to December 1953. He obtained the following information by conversations with Russian fellow convicts:

REFERENCE: SRI-E 3350

INFORMATION: It was in May 1952 when SOURCE first heard from Russian fellow convicts that an undetermined number of US personnel as well as British, French and South-Korean military personnel were interned in an unknown Russian convict camp in subject area. However, no details concerning strength, names and circumstances of prisonership of the above mentioned individuals were available by SOURCE. Around July 1953 he heard from Russian fellow convicts that these individuals were transferred to another unknown camp in the USSR.
