Item, I doe give and bequeath unto my Sonn Isaake Hunt seven ackors of land with a hous upon it purchasd of Baptist Smedley and Joshua Edmunds; alsoe, two ackors of medow, more or less, lying in my second devisiion; alsoe, twenty ackors of upland in the twenty scores; alsoe, fiftye ackors of land in the second devisiion already laid out and bounded; alsoe, sixteen ackors of the lot purchasd of Walter Edmunds running ouer the great hill; alsoe, two ackors of medow lying within the second devisiion of Jeans Blood; alsoe, a little piece of medow purchasd of John Smedley. Alsoe, I doe give and bequeath to my sonn Isaake Hunt one feather bed and boulster, two pillowes, one red rug, one blanket, one pillow bier, one fine sheet; alsoe, the bedstead in my hous at Concord, one great kette, one sword and belt, one Iron Calibo in my hous at Concord.

Item, I doe give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Barns two oxen in the hands of Henry Kearlye, of Lancaster, with rent due for them from the said Kearlye, one old kow, one two year old heifer; alsoe, one enbers cloth, one Cushin and bed valients, all of the same work; alsoe, one small Cushin; alsoe, I doe give to her child one mortar and pestle; alsoe, my Will is that the rest of my peuter not disposed of an a brass scumer be equally devided between my two sons Nehemiah and Isack Hunt; alsoe, my Will is that all that right in the village belonging to any of my lands in Concord be equally devided between my three sons, Samuell, Nehemiah and Isack Hunt; alsoe, given to my sonn Nehemiah Hunt one winscote Chest; alsoe, to his daughter, one owlde trunke; alsoe, my Will is that my son Isack shall have that piece of land cald Everel's lot; alsoe, my will is that my son Samuel Hunt should make a deed of saele of that eighteen ackors of land that I sould to Joseph Lampeon; I say that my Will is that my sonn Samuel make the said
