Joseph Robinson De Lano (Began life as a teacher, salary \$1. per week, in a summer school. By advice of father he accepted 75 cents per week, as his father argued; his employers might be less critical of his labor if he did not receive "such high wages." Successful in this he followed the vocation for several years, and received the highest pay for such at the time. When a mere lad he carried the United States mails, on horseback, over a part of the first mail route established in his native county. After two or three years as a clerk, he went to Wadhams Mills, starting a general merchandise store, continued many years. Later associated with him Messrs. Merriam, and they manufactured iron & handled lumber.
