

known church institution, Kenyon College, at Gambier, O., and was for many years a member of its board of Trustees. To this school he gave a bequest in a fund for the endowment of the Grammar department and the institution conferred upon him the honorary degree of LL.D. He also provided for the erection of "Delano Hall."

After retiring from public life Mr. Delano did not abate his interest in the affairs of the day, but kept closely in touch with all questions touching the prosperity of the nation. His advice was sought in regard to the provisions of the "McKinley tariff bill," and incidentally he devoted much time and labor to the work "of protection."
