Appointed midshipman Sept. 23, 1863 by Hon. Gideon Welles, Sec Navy. Served on "Constitution," "Marion," "Macedonian" & "Winnepeg" while at naval school, grad fr there June 1867.

Served in North Atlantic Squadron fr July 1867 to Dec. 1869 in flagship "Susquehanna" & "Contoocook" & gunboat "Yantic," then signal duty Washington, D. C.

Served in Pacific & Asiatic squadrons fr July 1870 to Dec. 1873 in "Mohican" & "Ashuelot."

Pacific station in "Portsmouth" fr Mar 1874 to Mar 1875. On receiving ship "Sabine" at Portsmouth Navy Yard fr Aug 1875 to May 1876.

North Atlantic fleet on "Shawmut" fr Sept. 1876 to Jan. 1877. Hydrographic Office, Wash fr Feb. 1877 to Apr 1877.

On U. S. S. Supply, training ship for apprentices, fr Apr 1877 to Aug 1877. On "Supply" fr Jan 1878 to Apr 1879. On torpedo vessel "Intrepid" fr Sept. 1879 to June 1882.

Pacific & Asiatic fleets in flagships "Pensacola" & "Richmond" fr June 1882 to Sept. 1884.

At Navy Yard Portsmouth fr Jan 1885 to May 1887. Also at Torpedo Sch & War Coll. On "Ossipee" fr May 1887 to Nov 1889. At Navy Yard Portsmouth fr Dec 1889 to May 1892.
