Washington then on his tour through New Eng.—in 1792 res. in Taunton—1800 received "warrant of cadet" orders to report for duty with Col. Lewis Tousard Comm't of Eng's at Newport R. I.—Entered Co. of Capt Stoddard there—1801 sent to West Point 1801
