

Italian marble, and is all in one piece except the base on which it stands." Two foundation pieces of smooth Indiana limestone—the smaller slab superimposed on the larger—form an enviroing step. The platform is surrounded by a plain brass-railing, with a gate at one side: the step being a kneeling place for the sponsors, or for an adult receiving baptism. The font was unveiled and consecrated on the festival of the Epiphany, January 6, 1895.
