LXXXVI. Jacobus, son of Thomas and Mary Garseling Swartwout, baptized in Fishkill, Dutchess County, province of New York, on November 3, 1754, married Martha, daughter of William van Wyck.

Memoranda. William lived in Virginia, near Washington, D. C., and died there unmarried. James (Jacobus) married, December 10, 1815, in the town of Fishkill, Deborah van de Water, and settled in Ohio, near Cleveland. Jacobus Swartwout, Sr., lived as had his father Thomas, on what was afterwards known as the Bailey-Montross farm.

Memoranda. William Swartwout settled in 1794 at Shokan, in the town of Woodstock, Ulster County, now in the town of Olive, and owned the farm later possessed by C. C. Winne. The Reformed Dutch Church of Shokan was organized on July 6, 1799, and incorporated on September 2, 1800. In 1801, Thomas Swartwout was one of its elders, and William Swartwout, a deacon. William Swartwout at the town meeting held in April, 1805, was chosen one of the road-masters of the town.
