Memoranda. When Simon Swartwout made his will on September 5, 1818, all his children were living. In a mortgage given by him, on May 1, 1806, the land (fifty acres) mentioned in it is described as lying at Stony Kill, in the town of Fishkill, on the Hudson River, and adjacent the land of John Rosekrans, Stephen Purdy, and Abraham Ter Bos. His will was probated on January 11, 1819. His daughter, Catharine Osborn, died in the town of Fishkill on November 18, 1873. Eliza married in Fishkill on April 6, 1828, W. L. Allen, born November 11, 1806.

Memoranda. His first daughter Catharine died in infancy. Hannah, the twin sister of Cornelius, married a Mr. Houtenbergh. The father, known as Major James Swartwout, served in the war of 1812-15. In his will, made October 31, 1815, all his children are named, except the first born daughter. He was then living in the town of Clinton, Dutchess County. His son James went to Saratoga County, N. Y., and nothing afterwards was heard of him.
