Memoranda. Johannes Swartwout having moved in 1795 from the town of Fishkill, in Dutchess County, N. Y., to Saratoga County, N. Y., settled in 1797 in the town of Palatine, (March 18, 1808, town of Oppenheim) Montgomery County, N. Y. His daughter Phebe died June 13, 1809. Abraham died, May 30, 1868, in Canada.

CXI. Sarah, daughter of Jacobus and Aaltje Brinckerhoff Swartwout, born in the town of Fishkill, Dutchess County, province of New York, on December 23, 1760, married in Fishkill, on May 20, 1790, Edward Hunting, M.D., and died July 18, 1793, without offspring.

CXII. Derick, son of Jacobus and Aaltje Brinckerhoff Swartwout, born in the town of Fishkill, Dutchess County, province of New York, on August 21, 1762. He had two wives, Lucretia and Elizabeth Polhemius, and died at Rockland Lake, Rockland County, N. Y., on April 24, 1852, aged 90 years, 8 months, and 3 days.

Memoranda. His son John died December 25, 1814; Eliza, September 18, 1819, and Elizabeth' in 1851; George, September 20, 1851, and Ann, March 4, 1866. On September 28, 1786, Derick Swartwout was appointed "paymaster in the regiment of militia in the County of Orange, whereof John Roberts, Esquire, is lieutenant-colonel-commandant."

By the will of his father, made October 23, 1823, Derick Swartwout was bequeathed the farm, embracing three hundred and eighty-four acres, on which he was then living, in Rockland County, bordering upon Rockland Lake.
