Memoranda. Jacobus Swartwood, with his brothers, Isaac and Emanuel, settled in 1797, in the valley of Cayuta Creek, in Tioga (now Chemung) County, N. Y., near the site of the station of the Elmira, Cortland, and Northern Railroad, now known as Swartwood, where they were shortly afterward joined by their father, and his brother John, with their families. Jacobus Swartwood opened there, in 1801, the first wayside inn in that locality. He built upon its site the hotel of which his grandson, Jacobus, became proprietor. Besides being the first post-master there, he was for many years supervisor of the old town of Spencer, and in 1828 represented Tioga County as an assemblyman in the state legislature during its fifty-first session. He was appointed on March 31, 1802, a captain in Lieutenant-Colonel Samuel Seymour's regiment of Tioga County militia.

Memoranda. Isaac Swartwood built, in 1800, the first saw-mill in the valley of Cayuta Creek, near the site of Swartwood, and, in 1803, the first grist-mill operated in that locality. He died near Owego at an advanced age. His son, who obtained the title of captain in militia training days, occupied a part of his father's farm.

CCXCIV. Jonathan, son of Peter and Elisabeth Schoonmaker Swartwood (Swartwout), born in Exeter, Pennsylvania, in 1784, married Elisabeth, daughter of Jacobus and Catharine van Etten Swartwout, born in Maghaghkemeck, Ulster County, N. Y., on April 6, 1796, and died in Cayuta, Tioga County, N. Y., on November 5, 1849, and he at the same place, on October 24, 1847.
