Memoranda. John Orlando died September 9, 1851; Theodore, December 19, 1862; and Edward, April 26, 1862. Their father, John Swartwout, served as a soldier in the Civil War, and also his son, William M. His daughter, Emma J., originated "The Delsarte Manufacturing Company," formed November 13, 1888, with a factory in Newark, N. J. She obtained the first patents and originated most of the designs of the Aesthetic Dress Reform, founded upon the Delsarte system of physical culture.
