Memoranda. Edgar Swartwout Dudley began his military career in the Civil War. On May 28, 1864, he was mustered into the service of the United States as a second lieutenant in the First New York Light Artillery, served in the fortifications at Washington, D. C., and was honorably mustered out on November 28, 1864. On September 1, 1866, he became a cadet in the United States Military Academy at West Point, N. Y., was graduated number 15 in a class of fifty there, and received on June 15, 1870, a commission as second lieutenant in Second United States Artillery; on October 29, 1875, promoted first lieutenant in Second United States Artillery; in 1876, detached as instructor of military science and tactics in the University of Nebraska, at Lincoln, Neb., until 1879. In 1884, detached again for the same until September, 1888. In 1891, rejoined the battery. On December 20, 1892, he was made assistant-quartermaster with rank of captain. Accepted December 23, 1893.
