JOHN ALVORD (*Jonathan, Alexander*), born Northampton, Mass., June 28, 1696; died Easthampton, Mass., Feb. 14, 1780; married Northampton, Mass., Aug. 4, 1721, Prudence Baker, daughter of Timothy and Sarah (Hollister) Baker. She was born May 14, 1687; died Northampton, Mass., Aug., 1752. Res. Northampton, Mass. Children:

She lived twelve years at Joseph Warner's, died of fits.

In 1738 John Alvord and his brother Jonathan lived in the same house on Prospect St. They divided the house between them. It was located nearly opposite Talbot's house near Mr. Stoddard's. He was in tax list, 2 polls, 33 est. John Alvord, son of Jonathan, is also mentioned as having his homestead in the Plain, called Ft. Plain. He bought the place of Josiah Searls. In 1730 John Alvord drew a home-lot in Southampton, Mass. He was appointed packer of meat in 1746, 1755, 1766-68. He died at the home of his son John in Easthampton.

The will of John Alvord is on file in the Probate Office at Northampton, Mass., but was never recorded. He mentions sons Zebadiah and John Alvord.

"Item, daughter, Sarah, wife of Ebenezer Mattoon of Amherst. Item, Sarah Mattoon and Eleazer Mattoon children of my daughter Sarah. Item, daughter Mary Alvord.
