75. JOSIAH ALVORD (*Josiah, Benjamin, Alexander*), born Sunderland, Mass., Nov. 12, 1735; died probably at Butternuts, N. Y.; married prob. Windsor, Mass., Mrs. Lucy (Perrin) Lyon, widow of Jacob Lyon, daughter of Nathaniel and Phebe (Holmes) Perrin. She was born Woodstock, Conn., Nov. 13, 1746. Res. Windsor, Mass., and Butternuts, Otsego Co., N. Y. Children:

Josiah Alvord, Jr., a resident of Montague, Mass., in 1776, conveyed land in Montague, bordering on land of Benjamin Alvord, to Ebenezer Nims. He must have moved to Windsor, Mass., about this date, for he married the widow of Jacob Lyon there before 1780. Jacob Lyon died in the Revolution in 1776. Land records show that Josiah Alvord was of Windsor, Mass., in 1800. Four years later Josiah Alvord and his wife Lucy of Butternuts, Otsego Co., N. Y., conveyed land in Windsor, Mass., to John Chamberlain of Windsor. A Josiah Alvord was living alone at Cazenovia, N. Y., in 1800. (U. S. census.)

Rev. War Service: "Alvord, Josiah, Jr., Montague, (also given Sunderland), 2nd. Lieut. Capt. Moses Harvey's 5th Montague Co., 6th Hampshire Co., Reg. List of officers of Mass. Militia commissioned May 7, 1776. Also Lieut., Capt. Joseph Slarrow's Co., Col. Ezra Wood's Reg. Enlisted Aug. 9, 1778; dis. Nov. 10, 1778; service 3 mos. 1 day, at Peekskill. Also order for wages dated New Milford, 2nd. Hill, Oct. 28, 1778."

"Alverd, Josiah, Jr., Sunderland, 2nd. Lieut., Capt. Moses Harvey's (5th) Co., Lieut. Col. Samuel Williams' (Hampshire Co.) Reg. Return of men in service, Dec. 30, 1778; enlisted May 10, 1776. Roll dated Warwick."

"Alvard, Josiah, Jr. Montague, Lieut. Capt. Thomas Grover's Co., Col. Williams' Reg., which marched on the alarm of Apr. 19, 1775. Service 18 days. Also Capt. Joseph Slarrow's Co., Col. David Leonard's Reg. Enlisted Feb. 25, 1777, dis. Apr. 10, 1777, marched to Ticonderoga."

"Alvart, Josiah, Private, Capt. William Clark's Co. Col. Benjamin Simmond's Reg. Enlisted Oct. 13, 1780; dis. Oct. 18, 1780; service 6 days. Marched from Windsor to Shaftsbury by order of Gen. Fellows." (Mass. Soldiers in Rev.)

76. BENJAMIN ALVORD (*Josiah, Benjamin, Alexander*), born Sunderland, Mass., Apr. 8, 1739; died Nelson, Madison Co.,
