Daniel R. Wolcott married for his first wife Elizabeth Root. In 1819 he removed from Bristol, Conn., to Farmington, O., where he remained for two years, when he settled in Orwell, O.

SYBIL ALVORD (*Ruel, Seth, Thomas, Thomas, Alexander*), born East Hampton, Conn., May 30, 1777; died Holland, Vt., Sept. 11, 1828; married East Hampton, Conn., May, 1803, Parmenas Watson, prob. son of Parmenas Watson.
