504. DANIEL ALVORD (*Daniel, Elisha, Joseph, Ebenezer, Alexander*), born Westhampton, Mass., Oct. 19, 1790; died near Lockport, N. Y., Oct. 18, 1854; married Jan. 8, 1815, Pamela Sackett. She was born perhaps Sackett's Harbor, N. Y., July 5, 1799; died Medina, N. Y., Oct. 10, 1875. Res. near Lockport, N. Y. Children:
