A COMPLETE CATALOGUE OF NEWSPAPERS IN WHATEVER LANGUAGE PUBLISHED IN THE UNITED STATES, TERRITORIES, AND DOMINION OF CANADA, WHICH INSERT ADVERTISEMENTS, ARRANGED ALPHABETICALLY BY COUNTIES AND STATES, GIVING THE LOCATION, NATURAL FEATURES, CHIEF PRODUCTS AND MANUFACTURES, COUNTY SEAT, POPULATION, AND VOTE BY PARTIES AT THE LATEST PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION OF EACH STATE, TERRITORY, AND COUNTY IN THE UNITED STATES, AND THE GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS AND CIRCULATION OF EACH PAPER ACCORDING TO THE LATEST AND BEST OBTAINABLE INFORMATION.

Populations in the United States, unmarked, are from the Official Reports of the Census of 1890, except in Michigan, where they are from the State Census of 1894. Those marked with an asterisk (*), are estimated. Canadian populations are mainly from the Census of 1891.

Circulations for which affidavits have been furnished are designated by an asterisk (*); those furnished by publishers, but not sworn to, are designated by a double-dagger (‡); those unmarked are estimated.

When statement of circulation is omitted, we have been unable to obtain any satisfactory information, or the paper was established during the current year, or entered for the first time in the ANNUAL, or else is issued for advertising purposes, in which latter case "adv." is placed in the circulation column. The word "decline" indicates that the publishers have declined or objected to furnish any statement for publication.

County Seats are indicated by a dagger (†). Unless otherwise specified the papers are issued weekly.
