Memoranda. Abraham married in Troy, N. Y., on February 6, 1809, Margaret Scott. He died in Lansingburg, N. Y., on February 23, 1855. Simon died unmarried on May 22, 1855. William married, and Mary Ann, his only child, married in Troy, on March 29, 1829, Nathan Gilbert of Troy. Samuel married in Wynantskill, Rensselaer County, N. Y., on March 11, 1809, Jemima Whitaker, born on February 9, 1790, and died on August 22, 1811. He died on October 8, 1826. Their remains are buried in Oakwood Cemetery. Alida married in Schaghticoke, Rensselaer County, N. Y., on January 22, 1825, John Robinson of Troy, born May 4, 1792, and died November 21, 1826. She died on June 16, 1860. Margaret married in Troy, on October 1, 1811, John Gabriel Gebhard. Sarah married on April 8, 1837, John B. Miller, born May 24, 1804, and died April 3, 1879. She died on April 23, 1866. Her remains are buried in Oakwood Cemetery.

On April 26, 1838, letters of administration were issued to Sarah, the widow of Cornelius Swartwout, and his son-in-law Benjamin Hatch. On April 15, 1843, James Swartwout of the town of Schaghticoke, Abner Loveland and Ann Eliza Loveland of Troy, Benjamin Hatch and Delia M. Hatch, Morton Fairchild, Alida Robinson, Cornelius Swartwout, Simon Swartwout, John Swartwout of Troy, Abraham Swartwout of the town of Lansingburg, and Henry Swartwout, jr., of the village of West Troy, released the farm in the town of Brunswick, to John B. Miller, which contained about one hundred acres, to which they were heirs by Cornelius Swartwout, deceased. Book of Deeds, 57, p. 210, in the office of the clerk of Rensselaer County, N. Y.

Elisabeth, daughter of Cornelis and Elisabeth Ter Bos Swartwout, born in the town of Fishkill, Dutchess County, province of New York, on October 16, 1759, and baptized in Fishkill, on January 13, 1760, married Cornelius Brinckerhoff. She survived him, and on April 29, 1803, united with the Reformed Dutch Church in Shokan, Ulster County, N. Y.

- XCVI. Simon, son of Cornelis and Elisabeth Ter Bos Swartwout, born in the town of Fishkill, Dutchess County, province of New York, on December 19, 1761, and baptized on May 16, 1762, married in Fishkill, on December 24, 1796, Mary, daughter of Cornelius and Eleanor Osborn, born on April 18, 1761, and died on January 17, 1807. He married second Ruth Purdy, born November 20, 1776, and died January 20, 1845. He died in the town of Fishkill, on December 9, 1818, and was living at that time, it is said, at Carthage Landing, or Low-point.
