U. S. Census of 1810 gives the residence of Isaac Alvord as Fair Haven, Vt., one boy and one girl under ten years, and one boy between ten and sixteen. In 1820 he is found at Murray, N. Y., with no boys and four girls under ten years, and two between ten and sixteen. In 1830 he was still in Murray (Kendall) with two girls in the family. Rebecca Alvord of Kendall, N. Y., deeded land in 1837. An old lady of Kendall remembers Isaac Alvord as a day laborer, and quite poor. She says he moved to Mich. about 1837.
