506. WILLIAM ALVORD (*Daniel, Elisha, Joseph, Ebenezer, Alexander*), born prob. Lanesboro, Mass., Mar. 22, 1795; died Brockport, N. Y., July 5, 1848; married Orpha Maria Gould. Res. Clarkson, N. Y., and Brockport, N. Y. Children:

William Alvord was a harness maker, a man of genial disposition. In deeds of property he is called of Clarkson, N. Y., in 1826 and 1832; became a member of the Cong. Soc. Clarkson, N. Y., 1829, of the church in 1831, dismissed 1831; admitted to Brockport Pres. Church May 12, 1833. Deed to Orpha M. Alvord of Brockport, N. Y., 1842.

507. ELISHA ALVORD (*Daniel, Elisha, Joseph, Ebenezer, Alexander*), born Georgetown, N. Y., Nov. 27, 1798; died near Lockport, N. Y., Apr. 25, 1852; buried on his farm; married Lockport, N. Y., Jan. 23, 1835, Amanda Howd, daughter of Bani and Betsy Howd. She was born Guilford, Conn., Jan. 23, 1809; died Lockport, N. Y., Jan. 22, 1898. Res. Lockport, N. Y. No children.

Elisha Alvord's farm was situated about one mile from those of Daniel and Samuel. Amanda Howd lived on the farm adjoining. The Howd family left Guilford, Conn., May 20, 1833, and arrived at Lockport, June 3, 1833.
