ELIAB KINGMAN<sup>6</sup> (*Eliab,<sup>5</sup> John,<sup>4</sup> John,<sup>3</sup> John,<sup>2</sup> Henry<sup>1</sup>*), son of Eliab and Jane (Todd) Kingman of Hingham, Mass., was born June 13, 1762. He married ANN KING of Charleston, S. C.

Mr. Kingman is said to have been the first person to open a boot and shoe store in Charleston, S. C., where his health was such that he had to give up business and seek a lighter calling. After retiring for a while he became superintendent of the "Orphan's Home" in that city for upwards of forty years. He was a highly respected and valuable citizen of the city of his adoption.

In the cemetery connected with the Wentworth Street Lutheran Church at Charleston, S. C., is the following inscription :

"ELIAB KINGMAN, Senior, a native of Hingham, Mass., but for nearly half a century a resident of this city, who departed this life on the 12th of Feb., 1835, in the 73d year of his age."

"Also to the memory of ANN KINGMAN, relict of the above, who departed this life on the 19th Sept., 1845, age 74 years, 3 months and 28 days."
