

12 Benjamin Twining, son of **6 Nathaniel**, b. June 3, 1728, Wrightstown; d. evidently in Warren county, N.J. Very little has been gleaned respecting Benj. The M. M. records show that he was disowned from among Friends 1758. Sold his farm of 53 acres near N., 1757, to John Harris, merchant. His house was the headquarters of Gen. Washington whilst in Newtown, immediately after the battle of Trenton in Dec., 1776. Was a tailor by trade. It has not been learned to whom he m. or the date thereof.
