Eli Grellet Jones, M.D. (brother of Richard M. Jones⁹) was the youngest child of Eli and Sibyl Jones. He was born in China, Maine, July 26, 1850. The most of his early education was obtained at Oak Grove Seminary, Vassalboro', Me., and at Friends School, Providence, R. I. In 1867 he decided to study medicine, and in 1869 he studied under Dr. F. A. Roberts, a homœopathic physician in Vassalboro', Me. He also spent some time under the instruction of Dr. D. P. Bolster of Weeks' Mills, Me., now of Augusta, a physician of the Allopathic School.
