


PEDIGREE OF THE LORDS WARD OF DUDLEY CASTLE.

\* This Viscount Dudley and Ward, married first, Anna Maria, daughter of Charles Bourchier, Esq., of the city of Dublin, by whom he had one son, John, his successor, and Viscount Dudley and Ward then married secondly Mary, daughter and heiress of John Carver, Esq., by whom he had another surviving son, William. The elder son succeeded Viscount Dudley and Ward in 1774. This second Viscount was an LL. D. and died s. p. in 1789, when the honors devolved upon his half brother, William, who was third Viscount, born Jan. 21, 1750, married Aug. 1, 1780, Julia, second daughter of Godfrey Bosville, Esq., of Gunthwaite, Yorkshire, by whom he had an only son, John William, who was distinguished for his high character. He died April 5, 1823, and was succeeded by his son, John William aforesaid, who was the fourth Viscount, and was created Viscount Ednam of Ednam, in Roxburghshire, and Earl Dudley of Dudley Castle in 1827, but died unmarried March 6, 1833, when the titles conferred on himself, together with the Viscounty of Dudley and Ward became extinct, while the Barony of Ward devolved on his second cousin, William Humble Ward, tenth lord, a clergyman, born Jan. 9, 1781, who married May 22, 1816, Amelia, daughter of William Gooch Pillans, of Bracondale, County Norfolk, and had: 1, William Ward, a peer after the death of his father, Dec. 6, 1835. He was created Earl of Dudley, 2, Hon. Humble Dudley, b. Dec. 20, 1821; d. Dec. 14, 1870; m. Dec. 17, 1843, Eleanor Louise, daughter of Thomas Hawkes, Esq., of Himley House, County Stafford, M. P. for Dudley, and had a son and two daughters, viz.: 1, William Humble Dudley Ward, b. Feb. 19, 1848; m. Oct. 14, 1878, Eugenie Violet Adele, daughter of Right Hon. Sir William Balliol Brett, P. O. (M. P. for Helston, 1868-8; 2, Amelia Alice Julia, m. 1865, James K. Fraser, Colonel 1st Life Guards (Bart.); 3, Henrietta Maria, m. 1869, George Stewart, son of Sir Charles Forbes, Bart. 3, Hon. Julia Susanna, m. 1842, Rt. Rev. Thomas Legh Claughton, D. D., Lord Bishop of St. Albans, 1877, and of Rochester. The Earl of Dudley, William Ward above-named, m. first, 1851, Salina Constance, dau. of Hubert de Burgh, Esq. She died 18th November following her marriage, and he m. secondly, 1865, Georgiana Elizabeth, dau. of late Sir Thomas Moncreiffe, Bart., and had six sons and a daughter.—*Burke's Peerage, Staff.
