FROM VOLUME OF NEVIS WILLS, ETC., 1764—1787, p. 176.

Order passed by Hon. Joseph Herbert, Esq., President and Ordinary of Nevis, dated 23 August 1767.

Whereas Joseph Herbert Pemberton, an infant under 14, hath petitioned by Lucretia his mother and W<sup>m</sup> Pemberton his Uncle that the guardianship of his (petitioner's) body was granted in the year 1762 to Horatio Herbert in conjunction with the said Lucretia Pemberton, and that the said Horatio Herbert now residing beyond sea, and being thereby incapable of acting as guardian, and prayed for the guardianship to be granted to Walter Nisbett and Edward Herbert, Esq<sup>s</sup>, instead of the said Horatio Herbert, and together with the said Lucretia Pemberton and William Pemberton, the guardianship was so granted till the said Joseph Herbert Pemberton should attain the age of 21 years.
