

David Middleton and Ellen Done had issue—

2. *Thomas Middleton* of Garthgynan, married Jane, daughter of Robert Fletcher, of Denbigh, and left issue, now believed to be extinct.

FULKE or FOWKE MIDDLETON of Llansannan, co. Denbigh, third son, was Governor of Denbigh Castle in the reigns of Henry VII. and Henry VIII. He married Elizabeth (or Margaret) daughter of Thomas Smith, of the Hough, co. Chester, alderman of Chester, and had issue several children, viz.—

RICHARD MIDDLETON, of Denbigh, eldest son. He was Governor of Denbigh Castle under Edward VI., Mary, and Elizabeth; M.P. for Denbigh in 1542-44; and Lieutenant to the Earl of Leicester, in the lordship of Caledwyn-yn-Rhos, now Denbigh. He married Jane, daughter of Hugh Dryhurst, alderman of Denbigh, by Lucy his wife, daughter and sole heir of Robert Grimsditch, of Rhuddlan, co. Flint. She died 31st Dec., 1565, aged 40, he died 8th Feb. 1575 [-6], aged 67, will p. 26 Feb., 1576-7. Both husband
