

The only Middleton in the foregoing list whose identity has not been established, is Henry Middleton, son and heir of David Middleton, deceased. "There was formerly, but not now, at Chirk Castle, a deed from Lewis Middleton to his father, David Middleton, dated 9 Nov. 2 James (1604) and another deed from David Middleton to Sir Thomas Middleton, and John Middleton dated 15 Oct. 4 James (1606)" (ex-inform Mr. A. D. Middleton (New York)). The David Middleton of these deeds was doubtless the father of Henry Middleton the New River Adventurer. He may have belonged to the Shropshire line.

(Page 8.) The following slightly extended list of the family of Robert Middleton, seventh son of Richard Middleton and Jane Dryhurst, may here be given.

ROBERT MIDDLETON, merchant and skinner, of London, married (1) Margaret, daughter of John Mansell, of Weymouth and Melcombe Regis, co. Dorset; and (2) Ann, eldest daughter of Sir Richard Saltonstall, Knight, Alderman, of London, and relict of John Harby, citizen and skinner, of London (who died 15 April, 1610.) His issue by his first wife only is as follows:—
