

26 Nov. 1607. "James Bisse Doctor of Divinitie Canon residensarie of the Cathedrall Church of Welles in the countye of Som'sstth." Wife Mary—children mentioned in general terms. Witness, Philip Bisse. Adm'on with the will 31 Oct. 1608 to Mary, the relict, no ex'or having been appointed. (90 Windebank.)

30 Aug. 1611. Adm'on to Philip Bisse, late of Axbridge, co. Somerset, dec^d, granted to Jane Bisse, the relict.

7 Oct. 1613. Philip Bisse, D.D. Bequest of books to Wadham College, Oxford—son-in-law Dr. William Hill—son Samuel Bisse—wife Bridget—son Thomas—to Sarah Hill, Sarah Swadell, Thomasin Bisse, and Elizabeth Bisse, children of my four children Sarah, Hester, Samuel, and Thomas £10 apiece—the mother of said Sarah Swadell dead—brother Richard Bisse—three sisters Johan, Agnes, and Alice—Judith Nayle my first wife's daughter—cousin Mr. Edward Bisse, the elder, of Spargrove—said Dr. Hill had 7 children by testator's daughter, they all living—grandchild and goddaughter Elizabeth Bisse, daughter of son Thomas—grandchild Philip Swadell. Witnesses, James Orenge and Robert Borde. Proved 2 Dec. 1613 by Samuel Bisse, the son. (114 Capell.)

8 Feb. 1614-5. Adm'on to John Bisse, late of St. Mary's, Savoy, dec^d, granted to Catherine Smith alias Bisse, the mother.

23 Oct. 1619. "I Joane Bisse of Pensforde in the county of Somerset, widowe." Son John Bisse—son Edward Bisse—daughter Dorothy Warman—John Bisse, son of said son John—Dorothy and Joan Warman, daughters of said daughter—mother Elizabeth—cousin Edward Bisse, Esq.—said son Edward under age—Elizabeth Bisse wife of said son John, Elizabeth daughter of the same, Mary Bisse daughter of the same, and Bridget Bisse daughter of the same—Thomas Warman son of son-in-law Thomas Warman, Elizabeth daughter of the same, and Mary Warman daughter of the same—daughter Dorothy, with child—son Edward Bisse, ex'or—James Bisse, an overseer. Proved 27 March 1620 by said ex'or. (27 Soame.)

11 June 1623. Richard Bisse of Croscombe, clothier. Son Philip Bisse—daughter Ann Bisse—son Charles—daughter Sarah—wife, and son Charles, ext'x and ex'or—cousin James Bisse, clerk, and brother-in-law John Casbeard, overseers. Proved 26 Sept. 1623 by Agnes, the relict, and Charles Bisse, the son. (88 Swann.)

17 June 1625. William Bisse of Croscombe, clothier. Daughter Elizabeth Bisse, who had a legacy given her by her grandfather Stroude—daughter Joyce Bisse—daughter Gertrude Bisse—daughter Martha Bisse—daughter Sarah Bisse—daughter
