

Thomasin Bisse—daughter Mary Webbe and her son William—daughter Amy Ruddock and her son Edward—son Thomas Bisse, if living—son William Bisse, if living—son Stroude Bisse—son James Bisse—son John Bisse—youngest son Edward Bisse—godson William Bisse, son of brother James—sister Hester Russe—friends Edward Bisse of Spartgrove, Esq., and Nathaniel Barnard, gent.—brothers James Bisse, Parson of Croscombe, and Robert Bisse of Shepton—lease of grounds called “Pynam”—wife living. Adm'on with the will 23 Aug. 1625 to the supervisors, Joyce Bisse, the relict, having renounced. (89 Clarke.) Sentence for confirmation registered. (129 Hele.)

23 Oct. 1626. Agnes Bisse of Croscombe, widow. Son Philip Bisse and his children—daughter Sarah Davies and her children—daughter Ann—sister-in-law Judith Casberd—daughter-in-law Joyce Bisse—son Philip's wife—brother John Casberd—son Charles, ex'or. Witnesses, James Bisse and John Cusbeard. Proved 23 Nov. 1626 by Charles Bisse, the son and ex'or. (117 Hele.)

4 July 1627. Adm'on to William Bisse of Croscombe, co. Somerset, but dying in parts beyond the seas, granted to Strowde Bisse, the brother. (Fo. 160.)

20 Jan. 1628. William Bisse of Tisbury, co. Wilts, tanner. John Wort, son of John Wort, and Alice Wort, daughter of the same—son-in-law John Wort and Avice his wife—Mary Bisse, daughter of William Bisse the younger—wife Avice—son William—brother Laurence Bisse, an overseer. Proved 30 Nov. 1629 by Avice, the relict, and William Bisse, the son. (100 Ridley.)

26 Sept. 1628. Gilbert Bisse, the elder, of Keyford, near Froome Sellwood, co. Somt, yeoman. Son Samuel—son John's children and his wife—said John living—son Gilbert—wife Edith—daughter Pitman—daughter Milles—daughter Holloway—daughter Mary—said wife and daughter Mary, ext'xes. Proved 14 Nov. 1629 by Edith, the relict, and Mary Bisse, the daughter. (93 Ridley.)

20 Aug. 1632. Thomas Bisse, clerk, Parson of Weston-super-Mare, co. Somerset. Wife Elizabeth—daughter Christiana Brace and son-in-law M^r Walter Brace—daughter Elizabeth Bisse, granddaughter of D^r Bisse, who left her £10—son Thomas Bisse—son Edward Bisse—M^r Cooke, fellow of Brasenose College, my son Thomas' tutor—cousin M^r William Bisse of Brasenose College, my son's reader. Proved 15 Feb. 1632-3 by Elizabeth, the relict and ext'x. (8 Russell.)

14 June 1633. Adm'on to Thomas Bisse, late of Westbury, co. Wilts, dec^d, granted to Mary Bisse, the relict. (Fo. 172.)
