

26 July 1665. Mary Allbin. Testatrix probably relict of Thomas Allbin—no children mentioned. Proved 29 Nov. 1665. (135 Hyde.)

22 Nov. 1666. Abigail Vandebrooke of Westham, co. Essex, widow. Daughter Elizabeth Bisse, wife of Edward Bisse, citizen and draper of London—grandaughter Elizabeth Bisse, daughter of said daughter Elizabeth—daughter Abigail Stint—grandchild Abigail Stint, daughter of said daughter Abigail—son-in-law Edward Bisse, ex'or. Proved 11 March 1671-2 by said ex'or. On 9 July 1700 adm'on of goods, etc., unadministered by said ex'or, granted to James Bisse, M.D., his son and adm'or. (36 Eure.)

14 Dec. 1672. Lucy Barber of Ashmoore, co. Dorset, widow. Eldest son Robert Barber—younger son Roger Barber—daughter Mabel Westfeild—niece and goddaughter Anne Ryves of Fyfehead, co. Dorset, spinster—son-in-law John Straight, clerk—George Barber, son of said Roger—brother William Harbin—George Barber and Robert Barber, sons of said son Robert—grandaughters Anne Ettrick, Lucy Langley, Elizabeth Ivy, and Bridget and Christian Barber, daughters of said son Robert—grandsons Jarvice West and Oswald West, children of daughter Gertrude, dec^d—grandson George Straight and granddaughter Lucy Cleeves—grandaughters Margaret Straight, Ann Straight, and Katherine Straight—grandson George Westfeild—grandaughter Martha Westfeild—grandsons John Westfeild, Richard Westfeild, and Charles Westfeild, and granddaughter Anne Westfeild—grandson Philip Bisse, residuary legatee and sole ex'or. Proved 13 March 1673-4 by said ex'or. (32 Bunce.)

Daughter Susanna Hodges—son Hugh Hodges—grandson Hugh Hodges—son-in-law Thomas Brickenden, clerk—daughter Elizabeth Brickenden—grandchildren Thomas Brickenden, Hugh Brickenden, Elizabeth Brickenden, Anne Brickenden, and Edmund Brickenden, children of said son-in-law—grandson Hugh Hodges, son of said son Hugh—kinsman Strode Bisse, cousin Joyce Bisse, and sister Frances Bisse their mother. Strode Bisse a witness. Proved 14 June 1673 by Hugh Hodges, the son. (79 Pye.)

12 Feb. 1674-5. Adm'on to Ralph Stent, late of St. Mary's Woolchurch, London, dec^d, granted to Abigail Stent, the relict.

28 Jan. 1678. Harry Symes of Frampton Cotterell, co. Gloucester, Esq. "Loving Daughter Jane now wife of Edward Byssc, Gent." Proved 12 Feb. 1682-3 by Ann Symes, widow, the relict. De bonis non 20 Oct. 1686 (said Ann then dead), 12 March 1690-1, and 23 Dec. 1708. (26 Drax.)

25 Jan. 1679. John Straight, M.A., Vicar of Turnworth, co. Dorset. Daughter Harding—daughter Bisse—daughter Cleeves—daughter Merry—daughter Romaine—daughter Katherine Straight—daughter-in-law Sarah Straight—daughter Harding's youngest son Jabez—son-in-law M^r Philip Bisse—daughter Margaret, wife of John Merry, clk.—son George Straight—daughter Katherine the younger, unmarried—wife dead—son John, ex'or. Proved 14 July 1680 and 12 Oct. 1680. (89 Bath.)

23 Nov. 1680. John Strangwayes of Marnhull, co. Dorset, gent. Wife Elizabeth—son-in-law James Bisse of Badcombe, co. Somerset, Esq., and daughter Grace his now wife. Proved 3 June 1681 by Elizabeth Strangwayes, the relict. (100 North.)
