Cæsar Thomas Gooch of Diss, gentleman; Zachariah Fincham of Diss, woollen draper;

Dated 12 Dec: 1755. Proved 7 May, 1756.

Charles Punchard. Ipawich, bookbinder.

Frederick Bush "who now lives with me", to be a partner in his business; and to have the tenement in St. Laurence, Ipawich, then in testator's occupation; Sarah Punchard, sister; George Jermyn, my partner; Robert Punchard, brother, executor.

Dated 8 May, 1879. Proved 21 Aug: 1789.

Robert Punchard. Norwich, upholster.

Sarah Punchard, sister; John Chambers and Robert Satchwell, his late wife's nephew; Thomas, son of his friend Thomas Potter of Hempton, Norfolk, gentleman; Robert Punchard Barwell, son of his cousin John Barwell; Harriott, wife of his said cousin John Barwell. John Barwell, cousin, and Thos. Potter, executors.

Dated 10 May, 1797. Proved 22 Mar: 1798.

Granted to Helen, the relict, 22 Apl: 1564.

Spinster. Granted to Henry, the brother of deceased, 28 Ang: 1588.

Granted to Henry, the brother, 19 May, 1892.
