Antrim, whose grandfather, Lieut.-Colonel Thomas Carroll, Commander of Carroll's Dragoons, was killed at the Battle of the Boyne 1 July 1690; born at 20 St. Patrick's Place, Cork, 19 January 1811; marr. at Cork 19 May 1836; died at York 9 June, bur. there 15 June 1849. 1st wife.

Alfred Greer of Dripsey House, co. Cork, and St. Patrick's Hill, Cork; born at Rhone Hill, co. Tyrone, 2 Sept. 1805; J.P. for co. Peggy, only dau. of Major John Bowen Colthurst of Dripsey Castle, co. Cork, by Peggy his wife, dau. of the Rev. William Billinghamurst of Mitchen Hall, Firgrove, and Poyle Park, co. Surrey; born at Cork 31 March, bapt. at Christ Church, Cork, 25 April 1815; marr. at St. George's, Hanover Square, London, 19 Nov. 1853; died at Dripsey House, 7 Feb., bur. at Douglas, Cork, 10 Feb. 1880. Will dated 14 August 1878, proved 22 March 1880. 2nd wife.





Thomas Greer of Sea Park, Carrickfergus, Strews, co. Tyrone, and Grove House, Regent's Park, London; born at 20 St. Patrick's Place, Cork, 4 April 1837, bapt. at Inniscarra, co. Cork, 24 Aug. 1851; High Sheriff of Carrickfergus 1870, and of co. Tyrone 1876, M.P. for Carrickfergus 1880-85, and was the last representative in the Imperial Parliament for that ancient borough; J.P. for the counties of Antrim and Carrickfergus, F.R.G.S. and M.R.I.A. *Portrait by Sir Thomas Jones, P.R.H.A., at Sea Park.*

Margaret, only child and heiress of John Owden of Sea Park, Carrickfergus, and Brooklands, co. Antrim, by Jane his wife, dau. of John and Margaret Greeves of Bernagh, co. Tyrone; niece of Sir Thomas Scambler Owden, Lord Mayor of London 1878, lineal descendant of Rev. Edmund Scambler, D.D., Bishop of Peterborough 1560-84, and Bishop of Norwich 1584-94 (*Portrait at Sea Park*); born at Brooklands 19 February 1842, and bapt. at Templecorran, co. George Newsom Strangman Greer, born at Kingstown, Dublin, 6 Dec. 1840, bapt. at Monkstown 20 Oct. 1848; died in New Zealand 7 Jan. 1867, and bur. there.

Flora Gertrude, born at Monkstown 18 May, bapt. there 20 Oct. 1848; died at Monkstown 23 March, bur. in Mount Jerome Cemetery, Dublin, 28 March 1855.

Amy Margaret, born at Clonmel, co. Tipperary, 23 Aug., bapt. at St. Mary's, Clonmel, 22 Sept. 1868.

Frederick Augustus Greer, born at Clonmel 20 Feb., bapt. at St. Mary's, Clonmel, 11 April 1871; Lieut. Royal Irish Fusiliers (87th Regiment).

Hugh Conrad Greer, born at Clonmel 19 Aug., bapt. at St. Mary's Clonmel, 23 Sept. 1873.
