


Owden, formerly of Brooklands, co. Antrim.



Arms on record in the College of Arms.
Gules, a garb banded or, on a chief of the last three human hearts of the first.

Crest.—A garb banded or, pendent therefrom a ring of gold, an escutcheon gules, charged with a human heart or.

Motto.—Confide recte agens.

John Owden of Anne, dau. of Thomas Scambler of Talbot House, London (lineal descendant of Edmund Scambler, D.D., Bishop of Peterborough 1560-84, and of Norwich 1584-94 (*Portrait at Sea Park*), whose arms were confirmed by patent 20 December 1585), by Elizabeth (née Muggeridge) his wife; born 25 June, bapt. at St. George's in the Borough, London, 17 July 1774; marr. there 2 February 1796; died at Cuckfield 17 March, bur. at St. George's in the Borough, 22 March 1842. Will dated 7 March 1842, proved 28 March 1842.

born in 1764; died at Cuckfield, aged 47, 25 April, bur. at St. Dunstan's, Stepney, London, 2 May 1811.

Anne, born at Cuckfield 5 August, bapt. there 26 August 1797; died an infant, and bur. at Cuckfield 23 May 1800.

John Owden of Brooklands, Belfast, and Sea Park, Carrickfergus, co. Antrim; born at Cuckfield 24 April 1799, bapt. there 17 January 1802; died at St. Anne's Hill, Blarney, co. Cork, 15 February, bur. at Grange, co. Tyrone, 22 February 1870. Will dated 21 August 1867, proved 22 April 1870.

Jane, dau. of John Greeves of Bernagh, co. Tyrone, by Margaret his wife, dau. of Thomas and Margaret Sinton of Moyallan, co. Down; born at Bernagh 10 October 1803; marr. at the Parish Church of St. Anne's, Belfast, 1 June 1841; died at Sea Park, Carrickfergus, 29 May, bur. at Grange 1 June 1871. Admon was granted 28 June 1871.

Margaret, born at Brooklands, Belfast, 19 February 1842, bapt. at Templecorran, co. Antrim; marr. at Belfast 28 July 1864, Thomas Greer of Sea Park, Carrickfergus, and Grove House, Regent's Park, London (eldest son of Alfred Greer of Dripsey House, co. Cork, and St. Patrick's Hill, Cork, by Helena his 1st wife, eldest dau. of Joshua Carroll of St. Patrick's Place, Cork, by Sarah his wife; born at 20 St. Patrick's Place, Cork, 4 April 1837, bapt. at Inniscarra, co. Cork, 24 August 1851; High Sheriff of Carrickfergus 1870, and of co. Tyrone 1876, M.P. for Carrickfergus 1880-85, and was the last representative in the Imperial Parliament for that ancient borough; J.P. for the counties of Antrim and Carrickfergus, F.R.G.S. and M.R.I.A. (*Portraits by Sir Thomas Jones, P.R.H.A., at Sea Park.*)
