Item I do give to my daught^r Elizab^h. Wiar my land at Cambr: line conteyneing foure acc^m more or less, I give it her & her heyres for ever after my decease. It^m. I do give to my Grand Child Elizab^h: Bacon six sheep & lambs now in her possession. I give it to her after my decease. Itm. I do give to my sonne Nathaniel Johnson the right & interest that I have in the house & land that his wife Joanna Johnson lives in, and further I give unto him the barne and land belonging to it, adjoyneing to y^e land belonging to the house of my sonne Nathaniel Johnson. the barne sh^ee is to haue possession of after my wifes decease & not before. I do give this house land & barne to my sonne Nathaniel if he be alive, if not then I give it to his two sonnes, they to possesse it w^h they come to the age of twenty one yeares, and my daughter Joannah Johnson to enjoy it till that time, And for the rest of my estate of housing lands moveables whatsoever elce that is my estate, I give it to my well beloved wife Elizab^h: Johnson for her comfortable lively hood, and if that sh^ee stand in need of supply I do give her pow^r to sell any part of the housing or land or the whole for her comfortable subsistance, and my will is that my well beloved wife haue pow^r to dispose of my household goods to any of her children either in the time of her life or at her death as sh^ee shall see cause, And at my wifes decease my will is that w^h of th^e estate shall then remaine of housing land or moveables undidisposed of shall be divided among my sonnes viz^t John Johnson Joseph Johnson Jonathan Johnson Nathaniel Johnson or his Children if he be dead, & Zachariah Johnson & Isaac Johnson, my eldest sonne to haue a double porceon Jn^o Johnson, the rest of my sonnes to haue equall p^{ts} of this estate that my wife may leave at her decease, And further my will is that my sonne Zachary Johnson should haue the Kill house, and y^e Mill in it, if so much fall to his share, if not he to haue the house & mill pajing to his Brethren the overplus that they haue equal shares according to the will, And I do appoynt my beloved wife my sofe Executrix of this my last will & testam^t made the 7th of decemb. 1677. and in testimony hereof I haue hereunto sett my hand.
