

being styled "of Ipswich," \* where he continued to reside until his decease, having, May 11, 1693, with the consent of his wife Elizabeth, and in consideration of their future maintenance, conveyed all his property at Ipswich to his son Joseph.†

Samuel Hunt, 1st, married, in 1656, Elizabeth, daughter of Joseph and Annice Reddinge. See that family, *Chapter XX.* She died February 16, 1706-7.‡

III. SAMUEL HUNT, 2d, of Billerica and Tewksbury, Middlesex County, Mass., (eldest son of Samuel, 1st, and Elizabeth,) was born at Concord, November 17, 1657.¶ Though his father removed to Ipswich, he resided principally at Concord until his removal to Billerica some time prior to February 18, 1691-92, when he purchased one-fifth of the Winthrop farm of 3000 acres. His plantation being next to the Indian Reservation, his house, near Wamesit, became the garrison, and was standing and known as such within the recollection of an old gentleman still living in the neighborhood. The site of the old house is now a plowed field, near Lowell, but the name of Hunt is perpetuated by a falls and ferry which still bear it. He was active in securing the incorporation of Tewksbury,¶ and died there, January 11, 1742-43, aged 85 years,\*\* having, April 11, 1723, with the consent of his wife Mary, made an agreement with their son Joseph by which he was to maintain them for the rest of their lives and pay his sister, Mary Dowse, the sum of £30.††
