

15, 1652; succeeded to much of his father's property at Killingworth, and occupied a prominent position in the town, having been its representative in the General Court of the Colony for the sessions from 1698 to 1716.*

Mr. Griswold married, first, at Killingworth, May 29, 1670, Mary Bemis, who died October 27, 1679, and, secondly, Bathsheba ———, who died March 19, 1736.†

IV. LIEUTENANT DANIEL GRISWOLD (son of John and Bathsheba) was born at Killingworth, Conn., October 25, 1696, and married Jerusha Stevens, March 9, 1721; afterwards removing to Saybrook, where all his children were born. He returned to Killingworth, where he died, September 10, 1737, and in the registers of the church is styled "Lieutenant of the Town Militia."||
