GUARDIANS OF MATHEWS GARDINER.

Appointment of Mathews Gardiner's Guardians:

By His Excellency Robert Hunter, Esqr., Captain-General and Governor of New Jersey, New York, &c., &c.:

To all whom these Presents shall come Greeting:

Know y^e that on the twenty-fifth day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & twelve, personally appeared before Jeremiah Ross, Esqr., being thereunto commissioned and appointed, Mathews Gardiner the only son of Thomas Gardiner, Esqr., Deceased, of the age of fourteen years & upwards, and desired that Abraham Bickley and John Willis might be admitted his Guardeans, which I have thought fitt to grant and they are admitted accordingly.

In Testimony whereof I have caused the Prerogative Seale to be hereunto affixed this first day of October in the Eleventh Year of her Majesty's Reigne, Anno Dom. 1712.
