Ogden is the grand junction of the Union Pacific, Central Pacific, Utah Central (now rapidly extending to connect with Senator Jones' railroad from San Diego), the Utah Northern, now in operation from Ogden into Idaho Territory, and branches building to Montana, Oregon, and Puget Sound; while the half completed iron works and silver production works that are sure to be built soon will necessitate the construction of a road to Smith's Fork coke mines.
