Present Condition. Good state of preservation: The plastering over the porch is in a state of disintegration. The original structure remains intact, with the addition of a side porch and one room about thirty years ago.

Number of Stories: Two.

Materials of Construction: Frame house with sheet metal roof, brick foundation. It has four octagonal columns on the front, the balcony over the front door has wood railings. The interior walls are plastered and papered. The stairway extends from the left rear to the left front. The house consist of eight rooms, and two halls.
