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course, both units probably identical as originally constructed; no. 303 (S unit) has small central wrought-iron balcony at second floor; no. 305 (N unit) has two-tiered cast iron gallery; side hall plan in each unit; twin dependencies formerly in rear. No. 307: brick, 29' -5" (four-bay front) x 79' including long ell, three stories (ell two stories), gable roof, double end chimneys, brick dentil course, recessed doorway with battered architrave, side
