History: Built in 1870 by James Wm. Finch as a home for his mother. Now occupied by the granddaughter, Mrs. Otto Fleischer.

Description: Stylistically, the house represents a type fairly common in the 19th century California, combining modified classicizing elements with touches of the

Victorian Gothic, and Italianate windows and doors.
Wood with shingle roof. The right wing and portions at
the back were added in 1881 and later.
