History: After separation of
banking business from expressPUBLISHED

Fargo Bank moved from Parrott's Granite Block
and was installed in a new building at NE
corner of Sansome and California Streets.
Building destroyed in 1906 fire.PUBLISHED

ment) brick and cast iron, apparently.
