EXTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE Decorative barge rafters and stickwork at gable ends. Ornamental iron grillwork above entrance porch. Decorative post capitals at 1st story porch, Enclosed sun porch with small paned wood sash windows.		
INTERIOR FEATURES OF NOTE (DESCRIBE FLOOR PLANS, IF NOT SKETCHED) Stone fireplaces. Redwood paneling in some rooms. Decorative redwood coffered ceilings in some rooms. Carved railing and balusters in main stairway.		
MAJOR ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS WITH DATES Front part built in 1881-82. Moved in 1908 to center of lot. Addition to original in 1908, adding two story addition to six bedrooms.		
PRESENT CONDITION AND USE Excellent condition - restored for use as bed & breakfast inn.		
OTHER INFORMATION AS APPROPRIATE Visible from Main St across Kelley Pond .. only part of total properties owned by Kelley family in Mendocino. Very impressive Victorian. Daisy MacCallum helped many families in Mendocino.
