- CA-179-23      LOOKING NORTH INTO FOUNDRY BUILDING WITH FOUNDRY CRANE INSIDE LARGE DOOR. THE CORE ROOM IS INSIDE THE SMALL DOOR ON THE RIGHT. CARL BORGH IN MAIN DOOR WEARING WHITE SHIRT.
- CA-179-24      LOOKING NORTH INTO FOUNDRY BUILDING WITH FOUNDRY CRANE INSIDE LARGE DOOR. THE CORE ROOM IS INSIDE THE SMALL DOOR ON THE RIGHT.
- CA-179-25      FROM SOUTH DOORWAY TO FOUNDRY FLOOR--GENERAL VIEW OF CRANE, TWO CUPOLAS, & MOLDS.

- CA-179-27      OPEN DITCH ON SHAKE RIDGE ROAD ACROSS FROM THE AMADOR WATER AGENCY. DITCH LEADS TO PENSTOCK GIVING 500' HEAD OF WATER TO KNIGHT FOUNDRY. VIEW IS TOWARD NORTHWEST KNIGHT FOUNDRY IS AT THE BOTTOM OF THE HILL IN THE BACKGROUND BEYOND THE RIDGE.

- CA-179-44 KNIGHT WATER IMPULSE TURBINES 12". THESE TWO TURBINES ARE SIMILAR TO THOSE THAT POWER THE FOUNDRY AND ENABLE PRODUCTION OF CAST MACHINERY PARTS SUCH AS THOSE IN THE BACKGROUND, RECENTLY MADE FOR RESTORING RAILROAD TURNTABLES IN CAMINO, FOLSOM, PLACERVILLE, AND PARIS, CALIFORNIA.
- CA-179-45 MACHINE SHOP NORTH/NORTHEAST INCLUDING OVERHEAD LINE SHAFTING. MOSTLY BELT DRIVEN WITH ONE ROPE DRIVEN LATHE IN MIDDLE GROUND. POWER COMES FROM KNIGHT TURBINE ON FAR WALL SHOWN IN K-77,78 (42")
