- CA-65-E-1                      Perspective view. looking southwest. The Curry Camping Company built the Women's Club ca. 1922 far up on the talus slope in an area called "The Terrace." At the time, The Terrace was the location of female employee housing and the Women's Club was lounge and recreation space for them. More recently, the building was fitted up as kitchen and toilet and shower facilities for both male and female employees living in the vicinity.
