- DC-17-2            General overview from the center of the site, view of the Washington Monument; view to southwest
- DC-17-3            General overview from the east end of the site, view of the open meadow and the National Aquarium building; view to north
- DC-17-4            Detail, Bulfinch Gatepost at the northwest corner of the site; view is to north-northeast

- DC-17-12 General view from center of site. This view is northwest
- DC-17-13 General view from center of site. This view is centered on the axis of the National Aquarium Building to the north; view is north



- DC-17-24            General view from Jefferson Pier along north-south axis toward the White House, view to north
- DC-17-25            General view from Washington Monument along east-west axis, showing alignment with the Washington Monument Lodge and the Capitol, view to east
- DC-17-26            Long general view from Washington Monument along east-west axis, showing alignment with the Washington Monument Lodge and the Capitol; note Smithsonian Castle to right of Capitol dome; view to east
- DC-17-27            General view from the Jefferson Pier along its north-south axis toward the Jefferson Memorial (far distant center); view is to south
- DC-17-28            General view from Washington Monument along east-west axis, showing alignment with the Lincoln Memorial, the Reflecting Pool and the World War II Memorial, view to west
- DC-17-29            General view of the Washington Monument Lodge showing south and east sides; view to northwest
- DC-17-30            Bulfinch Gatepost southwest of the intersection of Fifteenth Street NW and Constitution Avenue NW, with the Washington Monument in the distance; view to southwest
