Wilmington, New Castle County, Delaware

Owner: Mrs. Helen Rogers Bradford

Date of Erection: About 1826

Builder: Elijah Huxley for Joseph Price

Present Condition: Fair

Number of Stories: Two and one half with basement, main portion; service portion to rear two and attic, with one basement room adjoining main portion.

Materials of Construction: Stone foundation. Brick walls above grade; present roof tin. Wood construction, trim, floors, etc. Marble lintels over windows on front facade.

Other Existing Records: Offices of Recorder of Deeds and Register of Wills of New Castle County; article in Wilmington Every Evening January 10, 1914.

Additional Data: A good example of the city home of the wealthy class. Note the Greek Revival characteristics in the entrance porch and doorway and the flat lintels, and in the corner blocks which replace the usual mitred interior trim.
